LPN to BScN Pathway

Applicants who have completed a practical nursing diploma from a recognized Canadian institution and are currently licensed with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Saskatchewan (CLPNS) are eligible for the LPN to BScN Pathway.

The LPN to BScN pathway maximizes applicant's previous post-secondary education and experience as a Licensed Practical Nurse.



The Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing (SCBScN) LPN to BScN program is offered jointly by Saskatchewan Polytechnic and the University of Regina. As a SCBScN student, you will have the opportunity to access services and experience student life offered by both institutions.

When you graduate, you will receive a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) degree. You'll be ready to expand upon your current knowledge as a Licensed Practical Nurse and serve your patients in a different way.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants interested in the LPN to BScN pathway must have completed the following admission requirements:

- Completion of a practical nursing diploma from a recognized Canadian institution
- Proof of an unencumbered and unrestricted license with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Saskatchewan (CLPNS) at the time of application

WHEN TO APPLY:

October 1 to January 31

Deadline for applicants on study permit is **December 31**.

There is one intake per year, with courses beginning in the fall term.

Admission to the SCBScN LPN to BScN Pathway is based on a competitive entry process. Visit sasknursingdegree.ca for more information on the program, the application process, and deadlines.

All admission decisions will be made after the application deadline.

PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

The LPN to BScN Pathway is a full-time, two-year program. Students will complete their program in six consecutive terms. Many courses are offered on-site in Regina and Saskatoon with limited online or remote options.

INDIGENOUS STUDENTS

The LPN to BScN Pathway has designated 17% of new student admission seats for applicants of Indigenous Ancestry within Canada.

The SCBScN program also recognizes Indigenous people from the United States who belong to the Jay Treaty. Applicants within this category will be eligible for domestic tuition.

To qualify for designated Indigenous seat, applicants must submit proof of Indigenous citizenship.

Applicants within these categories must fully meet admission requirements.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Students admitted through the LPN to BScN Pathway will receive block credit based on the completion of their practical nursing diploma. Additional transfer credit will only be considered for courses completed which are not a requirement of the completed practical nursing diploma.

BLOCK TRANSFER CREDIT

Students admitted to the SCBScN program through the LPN to BScN Pathway will receive 36 credit hours of transfer credit.
